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# CICC NUTILETA 35

## **1. AKATOMO'ANGA**

**K**ia orana e te iti tangata tapu no te Atua i te au ngai katoatoa; to te Kuki Airani nei, tei noo ki Nutireni, Autireria, Tahiti, e te vai atura te au ngai tei taeaia e teia karere. E tau ia tatou kia akameitaki i te mana katoatoa koia tei oronga mai i teia tikaanga manea kia aravei akaou tatou na roto i teia pepa akakitekite numero 35. To tatou tuatua aravei e te akamaroiroi i to tatou oroanga akarongo, te na ko ra te irava mua o te reo imene Apii Sabati numero 294: *%Te ra Sabati nei, E ra manea tika'i, Te ra i eke mai nei rai, Te Atua maata nei.*"

Na kotou e akatotoa atu i teia karere ki to kotou au taeake kia kite katoa ratou i te au mea e tupu nei i roto i te taokotaianga o te kopu tangata CICC. Ko kotou kare i kite ana i te au nutileta i mua atu e kua anoano kotou kia kite, aravei atu i te Orometua o taaau Ekalesia me kore akakite mai kiaku; ka rauka oki te reira au nutileta i te tuku iatu na runga i te imere. Noatu e tei muri teia au nutileta, e maata te au mea puapinga i roto . . mei te tua tapapa o te au tuatau tei topa ki muri (personal profiles, history, etc.) . te ka riro ei pumaanaanga kia tatauia.

## **2. NUTI MEI TE EKALESIA MAUNGAREI,AKARANA**

**K**ia orana tatou katoatoa i te aroa maata o te Atua. Te mataora nei au no te tikaanga manea i akonoia e te Atua kia aravei tatou na roto i teia pepa akakitekite. Kia akameitakiia aia no tana tiakianga ia tatou mei te mua mai o te mataiti e tae rava mai nei ki te openga, e teia kua akatomo ia tatou ki roto i teia mataiti ou. Teia to Iesu reo, "ko au te tiaki mamoe meitaki ra: ka oronga te tiaki mamoe meitaki i tona uaorai ora no te mamoe" Ioane 10:11). Ko te tu tiaki teia ta tatou ka inangaro, e ora oki tatou i roto iaia. No reira ka apai i to tatou au rima i tautau ana ki raro ki runga ra, ka akameitaki atu ei iaia i te Atua i oraq tatou nei. Tetai au nuti poto mei roto atu i ta tatou Ekalesia i Maungarei nei.

### **ARIKIRIKIANGA I TE ARONGA PAKARI E TE AU TAKAU**

Kua manako au e, e mea meitaki kia tata akakite atu kia tatou i te au mea e tupu nei i roto i te Ekalesia Maungarei. Ko te mea mua, ko Maungarei, ko tetai ia o te au Ekalesia e tauta pakari nei kia rauka te nooanga meitaki e te au, e kia kitea katoa te kaka o te Atua i roto i tana e rave ra. Tuketuke tana au akateretereanga ei ravenga kia mataora te Ekalesia, ma te kite atu tetai ki tetai, e te aroaqanga atu tetai ki tetai. Tika mari ta te tuatua-tika ra e, "Ko te mea teia e kite ei te tangata ravarai e, e pipi kotou naku, e aroa kotou ia kotou uaorai".



E te au taeake, te vai nei te nuti ko taku ia e anoano nei i te tua, na kotou e akarongorongo mai. I te mua mataiti 2010, kua akanoo te Ekalesia i tetai tikaanga tau kia raveia tetai arikirikianga no te taime mua, ei ravenga nana kia oronga i tana akangateiteanga, kia kore e akangaropoina i tona au metua pakari, e pera katoa te matiroeroe e te au takaua i roto i tana Ekalesia. Ei akamaata atu i te manako no teia, te tuatua ra te reo o lesu, Ioane 14:18a, “*Kare au e vaio matiroeroe ua ia kotou*”. Kua riro tikai teia ei mea mataora ki te Ekalesia no te mea, ka tai nei teia i te raveangaia i roto iaia, e ka riro katoa teia ei manakonakoanga nona no te au mataiti ki mua.

Takake teia ki te au arikianga tei mataua e tatou Ekalesia tatakitai, mei te Mothers Day, Fathers Day e te vai atura. Ko te mea pumaana, kua orongaia te leta patianga kare i roto ua i te Ekalesia, mari ra kua akatoro katoa atu ki te au taeake i vao ake, kia ratou tei tauturu ana i te Ekalesia na roto i te au tu tauturu tuke e manganui. No reira i te Sabati ra 31 no Okotopa i te mataiti i topa 2010, kua akatupua te reira moemoea, kua piri katoa mai te au taeake ki roto i te akamorianga ma te taokotai atu ki ta te Ekalesia akamorianga. I muri ake i te akamorianga kua akanooia te arikirikianga, kua katikati kapipiti te au metua i patiia, te aronga pakari mei te 60 mataiti aere atu ki mua, te matiroeroe, e te au takaua. Mei tetai 30 te katoatoa anga ratou tei patiia.



Kua rai atu te mataora, no te ngakau maoraora i kitea ki roto i te au tamariki a te Atua, te putuputuanga Vainetini, te anau mapu, te anau apii Sabati, no ta ratou au pakau aroa, te au kara pareu tuketuke, te au ei natura e te ei raore venevene, reka i te akamanea anga i te au metua e te au taeake. Kua kitea te tu mataora, kua parara te taua no te au peu imene, te ura keresetiano, e te vai atura i te akakiteanga i te tu mataora me noo ki roto i te Evangelia a lesu Mesia.

#### **AKAARIARIANGA TIVAEVAE**

Inangaro ua au i te akakite i tetai au nuti no runga i ta te au mama vainetini o te Ekalesia Maungarei e rave nei. Takapini i te au ngai katoatoa kua kite ua tatou e, ko tetai putuputuanga maroiroi teia tei riro ei turuturu i te au putupuanga, pera katoa te au Ekalesia kia meitaki e kia manua i to ratou au akakoroanga. Ko te reira katoa ta te iti vaine angaanga e rave nei i roto i ta tatou Ekalesia. Kua kite ua tatou e tuketuke ta ratou au angaanga memeitaki i rave ana, te rave nei, e ka rave ua atu rai. Ko ta te Atua akameitakianga te reira ia ratou kia riro ei metua vaine meitaki e te akono, ko ta te Atu ina ko ra e, Matt 26:13, “*Koia mou taku e karanga atu kia kotou nei, Te au ngai katoa e tuatua'i teianei Evangelia i te ao katoa nei, e tuatua katoaia ta teianei vaine i rave nei, ei manakoanga atu iaia*”.

No reira kare e rauka kia uuna i tona maroiroi, e mea tau kia akakiteia, penei ka rirro te reira ei tauturu no ratou tei anoano i te rave i te mea meitaki. Kare te akaariari tivaevae i te mea ou, e akonoanga mataua teia e te au mama i te au ngai katoa. E kare katoa teia i te mea ou ki te au vainetini Maungarei, kua rave mai ana ratou i te reira i te au mataiti i topa, e te rave ua nei rai i teia tuatau nei. E manganui ratou te au metua vaine tei rave maroiroi mai ana, ma te akakoromaki marie i te au akaueanga e te au patianga tei orongaia kia ratou, kua tavaitai ua te ngakau ma te inangaro okotai i te turuanga atu i te angaanga, e te akakoroanga a te vainetini kia tere ki mua ma te manea e te meitaki. Ko te mea tangi ra, e maata katoa ratou tei tapapa na kia kite i te akiro e te puapinga o taua ra ra, kare ra i kite no te mea kua moe atu ratou i te moeanga roa. Kia akameitaki ia ra te Atua no te maroiroi tana i oronga ki te au metua vaine kia kore roa e akangaropoina i ta ratou tuanga, i te rakeianga i te manea o te tivaevae ei kaka no te Ekalesia e no tana Evangelia ora.

I te mataiti i topa akenei, i te Manakai ra 27 no Noema 2010 kua rave akaou atu te au mama vainetini o Maungarei i ta ratou akaariarianga tivaevae. E okotai mataiti te roa ta ratou tapapaanga ma te akateateamamao kia papa no taua ra ra. Kua tupu te mataora i te maneoa te angaanga tei raveia, e maata tei tae mai no te matakitaki, kare i te mama ua tei tae mai, mari ra e te au papa katoa, no te mea kua inangaro tikai ratou kia kite mata i te akaieie o te au tivaevae, e te katoa anga o te au apinga tuitui ta te au mama i akateateamamao. Tau mari ei te tuatua a Toma ko tei na ko e, kia a'a rava aia e irinaki ei.

I te mea oki e ko te mataiti tauianga Orometua teia, penei ka manga tuke katoa te akanoonooanga porokaramu no te Ekalesia, to te vainetini, e no te au putuputuanga katoatoa. Inara, ka akara atu tatou kiaia ki te Tumu e te Akaoti o te au mea ravarai, koia anake tei kite i to tatou au aerenga katoa, nona oki te marama e te kite, te pakari e te karape, te maroiroi e te ririnui tei tanumia ki roto ia tatou katoatoa ei meitaki no tana Evangelia , e ei kaka no te Atua.

Ei taopenga i teia nuti akakitekite, teia te manga tuatua a lesu, Ioane 15:7. *"I topiri mai kotou kiaku ra, e kia noo marie taku tuatua ki roto ia kotou na, e pati ua kotou i ta kotou e anoano ra, e e orongaia mai ia kotou".*

No reira ko te manga nuti tena no konei atu i to kotou au taeake. Tera ua te irinaki nei e, kua mataora ta kotou au Xmas e pera te mataiti ou. Na te Atua tatou e tauturu mai, e nana katoa e akaaravei akaou ia tatou na roto i te au tuatau ka aereia e tatou ki mua.

**K**ua tupu teia moemoea i roto ia Titema 2009 na roto mai i te Papa e te Mama Orometua o te Eklesia Matavera, e kua turu pakariia e te au Puapii Sabati. Kua akanooia tetai porokaramu no te kimikimi ravenga, ma te akanooia tetai tino moni no te akamata i te akakoroanga no te apai i ta matou anau tamariki apii Sabati i te tuerto ia Akarana, Niu Tireni. Kare te akakoroanga o te tere i te kimi moni, e apai ra i te tamariki kia kite i te au ngai tei akakoroia no te tamariki ei kiteanga na ratou. Kua akaruke atu te tere ia Rarotonga nei i te Paraparau ra 23 no Titema 2010 e kua oki mai i te ra 3 no Tianuare 2011.

Kua akatuangaia matou e 4 pupu e kua akamataia teia angaanga kimikimi moni i roto Tianuare 2010 ki te marama Tiunu, i te irinakianga ka taeia ta matou i akanoo no te tutaki i te au ngai i tamanakoia no te tuerto atu. I roto i te marama Tiurai, kua akatinamouia te porokoramui tei akanooia no te tuanga o te Evangelia e pera te au ngai ka tuertoia. Kua raveia te akainuanga e te Orometua Ngateitei, Rev. 

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



Ko tetai metua tane maroiroi teia i te kimi ravenga no te akatupu i ta tatou akonoanga CICC i Hamilton, e pera i te tauturu i to ratou Orometua i teira ra koia a Maara Tairea. Ko tona tokorua ko Mama Tangianau Ngatupuna te Tekeretere o te Ekalesia Hamilton i teia ra, e metua vaine maroiroi katoa i roto i te Ekalesia.

Tena i reira e te au taeake tetai manga iti o te tuatua o te metua tane Papa Turama Ngatupuna. Te karanga ra te tata Salamo 70:1 “*Kia ora au ia koe e te Atua; kia ngakoikoi, e lehova, e tauturu mai iaku.*”

Kua riro ana a Matamaru ei arataki no te anau mapu i roto i te Ekalesia Arutanga. I te mataiti 1970 kua tere atu aia ki nutireni e kua tomo ki roto i te akonoanga P.I.C i Tokoroa no tetai 10 mataiti.

Mei Nutireni kua tere atu a Matamaru ki Autireria i te mataiti 1982. Kua tomo atu ki roto i tetai Ekalesia e au tangata Kuki Airani to roto, kare oki ta tatou akonoanga CICC i akatupua ake i te reira tuatau. I roto i teia akonoanga kua riro mai aia ei metua apii i te imene reo metua e te reo Apii Sabati. Kua riro katoa aia ei mou moni no teia taokotaianga e pera ei arataki no mapu no tetai 7 mataiti.

E te au taeake e maata uatu rai te au angaanga ta teia metua tane i rave i roto i te au Ekalesia tana i noo ana e tae rava mai ki tana Ekalesia i teia ra koia te Ekalesia Hamilton. Ko tona inangaro e te noinoi i te Evangelia a lesu Mesia, no te mea oki e na tona uaorai tupuna ko Tamatoa Ariki i mou mai i te Evangelia ki runga i tona enua anauanga, mei tei taikuia i runga nei. E ngakau parau tona i tona tupuna, e ngakau parau katoa i te akakiteanga i te tuatua ora a to tatou Atu ko lesu Mesia ki te tangata ravarai.

Ko Matamaru te Tekeretere o te Uipaanga Diakono i roto i te Ekalesia Hamilton i teia ra, e riro nei tona tokorua a Mama Mata ei tauturu tau e te tauturu maroiroi iaia i roto i te au tuanga katoatoa a te Ekalesia.

# Annex II

## REFLECTIONS

### JOURNAL OF A VOYAGE

*This is a 9-part series of the record by Rev. John Williams during his trip to the Cook Islands in 1823. Deciphered from the original by Winnie Risto in March 2010 while residing with husband Herbert Risto in Rarotonga. Some punctuation has been added by Winnie to enhance the meaning, but most has been left as it was in John Williams' Journal. The Ristos are from Canada and have been visiting Rarotonga since the 1960s; Herbert teaches at the Takamoa Theological College while in Rarotonga.*

#### Chapter 4



The Captain, not liking to trust the boat determined to go with them himself. A short time after the boat left we saw two canoes paddling off toward us very slowly. We could not induce them to come near us by any means. The boat returned without being able to get anyone to come off. The Captain rowed towards one of the canoes. As soon as the boat got close he paddled off with all his might. We tried interesting him with knives. He got near with his canoe and rowed towards the vessel, towing his canoe along with him. When they came along we used every means in our power to get one of the men on board. We showed them the Aitutaki Chiefs and the Rarotonga people we had on board. They exhorted them not to fear, telling them that this was a ship of God and we should not hurt them.

After our persuasions one man came on the ship but was greatly agitated and trembled much. The other man, as soon as his canoe was loosened from the boat, paddled off with great joy and took good care not to come again within reach. Looking very significantly at the vessel, her stern, the heights of her masts he said- indeed, yours is a land of fine canoes. We desired him to go on shore and tell his friends who we were and what our object was.

The language of this people, being similar to that of Rarotonga and Aitutaki, we did not find it very difficult to converse with him. We asked him first the name of the Island. He told us Kaia. We asked him how many chiefs there were. He replied three- whose names are Kaiau, Maong-nui, and Nui Maanga a tini. We asked him how many gods they worshipped. He replied that they had two principal ones . Tane and Rongo. There were also two great maraes. We asked him if they destroyed their infants. He said, no. We asked him if they offered human sacrifices. We understood him that they offered them after they were dead, but did not kill them for that purpose. We asked him if it would be safe for the teachers to go on shore. He replied that they were a people who did not kill men and they would be safe. We asked him if they were at war with each other. He replied no. We enquired of him the nature of their food. He told us they had cocoa nuts, taro, breadfruit, plantains, bananas, yams and sugar cane. The sugar cane appeared amazingly fine. He enquired very particularly about the vessel's name, saying that this was the second vessel they had ever seen. Captain Cooks is the first. They have neither pigs, fowls, cats or dogs. Having by this time arrived at the landing place we proposed his going on shore with the teachers.

He, with trembling steps, got into his canoe and told the teacher to wait while he bailed it out - instead of which he let go the rope and rowed off as hard as he possible could. We wished him to stay on board and go with us but he would not consent. We determined to send the boat again on shore with the teachers and Papeiha, to see the Chief and have some conversation with him . there being no entrance or harbor and the natives being afraid to come near the boat with their canoes, there was no alternative but jumping overboard and swimming through the surf, which Papeiha did. The king received him very kindly. Papeiha told him our wish that he should come on board but he would not consent. He told him that there were two teachers, with their wives, on board who would come on shore with him to teach him and his people the word of the true God of which he expressed his interest. They returned to the vessel and informed us that the people appear very quiet- that the Chief had expressed his wish for the teachers to come on shore and that there

was no war. The teachers prepared immediately to go on shore. The canoe we purchased at Aitutaki we found very useful . There being no landing place we were obliged to go through the surf over the reef. They put their bedsteads and other property into the boat and started again for the shore. The people collected down toward the part of the reef over which they went in reaching the shore, everyone with his spear. Papeiha desired them to take them all away or they would not land, upon which they bound them all together, carried them on shore and left them. The canoe then landed, having among other things live pigs. The natives dragged the canoe and all that was in it into the bush. The pigs they wrapped up very carefully with the best of cloth and carried them with equal care to the house of the Chief. The oil that the teachers were taking on shore (perhaps the first the natives ever saw) they thought valuable indeed as it made their bodies shine very much. They poured it by bamboos full on each other's heads.

After much difficulty the canoe was got off again- when Haavi and his wife, with the wife and children of Tauaa- the other teacher who was on land waiting the return of the boat to go with the remainder of their little property. As soon as the canoe landed with Haavi and his wife and the wife and children of Tauaa, there was a general seizure of all that they had. A box of bonnets intended for the Chief's wives they dragged into the sea and broke to pieces, everyone taking what he could get.

Each one took his part and made off. Their calabashes and coconut cups shared the same fate. Their two axes were among the first things that were seized from them. Haavi had a \_?\_ which the men seized from him, each man taking a piece. Their box of clothes, and, indeed, every article they had, was seized from them, not excepting that they had on them. Papaiha had a fringed cloth round him. They cut off the fringes for ear ornaments. Haavi had a shirt on, the tail of which they tore off in strips like ribbons to ornament their heads and ears with. The women's hair(?) nets and the men's hats were torn off their heads, but what completed the whole catastrophe was their most vile conduct towards the wives of the teachers.

As soon as they landed, they seized them. While some were seizing the property, others were ill using the women. They dragged them through the water, pulled them about in the most indecent manner in order to gratify their vile passions. They seized them by their throats, threw them down on the ground, endeavored to tear off all their clothes, and all the rough and indecent means they could to accomplish their wicked purpose. The husband could render no assistance as he had a child or two of his colleagues to take care of, besides which four strong men were holding him down. The poor woman's condition was in the extreme. Their only protection was the Chief, who sat between them and held their clothes and preserved them from the insults of the people as much as he was able, his authority over the people not being great. He was not able to do much for them for some of the ruffians were holding them down while others were holding their legs and others endeavored to tear off their clothes but they having European clothing on it was a great means of preserving them. The Chief at length rescued them. Then several stout men came and seized one of the women and were carrying her away into the bush when the Chief again rescued her from their licentious grasp.

As soon as he had obtained quietness he asked them what they had come for and what was their business. They told him that they, like himself, were once ignorant of the true God and His Son, Jesus Christ, that their only wish was to instruct him and his people in the worship of the true God. He replied saying he would be glad to receive them but in his land all heads were equal- that the people would not listen to him, his influence and authority was not sufficient to afford them protection. He therefore begged them not to be obstinate in remaining.

By this time the boat with Tauaa and the remainder of their property — but they decided all with one accord not to remain but to return on board immediately as the chastity of the women as well as the lives of the men would be sacrificed to the brutality of lust.
